What's The Problem?

- Canadian Youth (16-24) have the highest rate of mental health and addiction concerns of all age groups
- 7.5million youth under 25 have Mental Health Challenges
 - This increases an ave of .8% each year
 - 70% say they noticed symptoms before 18yrs
- Of those seeking mental health support, met with a 6m-2.5yr wait list
